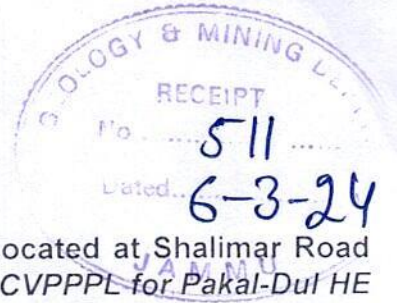

Subject:- Letter of Intent (LoI) w.r.t 0.91 hectares of Quarry Site located at Shalimar Road on Government land, District Kishtwar, J&K in favour of CVPPPL for Pakal-Dul HE Project.

Whereas, the Government in the J&K Mining Department conveyed approval vide No.GM-MNG/299/2023-02, dated 28.02.2024 for reservation of the aforementioned 0.91 hectares of Quarry Site located on Government land under Khasra No.4260 at Shalimar Road, District Kishtwar, J&K in favour of Chenab Valley Power Projects (Private) Limited, in short CVPPPL, a Joint Venture of the National Hydro Power Projects Limited, in short NHPC (A Govt. of India Enterprise) and J&K Power Development Corporation, in short JKPDC (A Govt. of J&K Enterprise) for mining to facilitate providing of the key construction material for use only in the **Pakkal Dul HE Power Project, Kishtwar;**


And whereas, in exercise of powers vested with Director, Geology and Mining, J&K, under Rule-91 of *The Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Concession, Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining Rules, 2016*, notified vide S.R.O-105 dated 31.03.2016, the aforesaid Quarry Site with Geo-coordinates of the Corner points (A=33° 18' 0.41" N 75° 47' 15.52"E; B=33° 18' 03.91" N 75° 47' 16.25" E; C=33° 18' 2.85" N 75° 47' 19.69"E; D=33° 18' 0.18" N 75° 47' 19.30" E) has been reserved by way of issuance of the required Public Notice vide this office No. 1238/MCC/DGM/QL/Kisht/22/1230-36 dated 04.3.2024, which has also been published vide DIP No.J-15731/23 dated 04.3.2024 in the widely circulated Daily Newspapers of the UT of J&K on 05.03.2024 (Tuesday) viz. Daily Excelsior Jammu (English), Udaan Srinagar (Urdu) and Amar Ujala Jammu (Hindi);

Now therefore, this Letter of Intent (LoI) is issued in favour of Chenab Valley Power Projects (Private) Limited with the following conditions:-

1. That, CVPPPL shall submit Approved Mining Plan, Environmental Clearance, Consent to Operate and NOCs of all concerned stakeholder Departments as per devised format by the J&K Environment Impact Assessment Authority (JKEIAA) enabling this office to grant Quarry License in favour of the CVPPPL for extraction of minor minerals from Quarry Site located on Government land at Shalimar Road, District Kishtwar, J&K.
2. No mining/extraction shall be allowed from the said Quarry Site till the formal Quarry License is granted to the CVPPPL under rules.

This Letter of Intent (LoI) is provisional and shall be further subject to obtaining any other requisite/statutory clearance under any Law/Rules governing the subject and shall also be subject to the outcome of any Writ Petition(s) pending before any Court of Law including concerning any third party dispute, as may be applicable to this case.
