**Subject:- Letter of Intent (LOI) w.r.t Minor Mineral Block-30/J, Sardan Nallah, District, Jammu.**

**Whereas**, E-Auction of **Minor Mineral Block-30/J** with the description, '**Sardan Nallah District, Jammu**', covering an area of **2.00 hectares** with Geo-coordinates of corner points (**A= 32° 45' 45.62" N 74° 58' 59.68" E, B=32° 45' 42.89" N 74° 58' 50.07" E, C=32° 45' 47.02" N 74° 58' 47.06" E, D=32° 45' 46.15" N 74° 58' 52.70" E, E=32° 45' 46.38" N 74° 58' 59.43" E**) was conducted by the District Auction Committee under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Jammu on 12.03.2024;

**And Whereas**, Deputy Commissioner, Jammu vide communication No. DMJ/LO/23-24/5058-59 dated 15.03.2024, informed that you has emerged as highest bidder in the above said E-auction in respect of said Minor Mineral Block;

**And Whereas**, as informed by the Deputy Commissioner, Jammu, the highest bid of **Rs.1,97,58,000/- (Rupees One Crore, Ninety Seven Lakhs and Fifty Eight Thousand only)** has been accepted by the Chairman District Auction Committee ( Dy. Commissioner, Jammu) and recommended to the Director, Geology and Mining, J&K for issuance of Letter of Intent (LoI);

**And Whereas**, 50% of the bid amount (highest bid) amounting to **Rs. 98,79,000/- (Rupees Ninety Eight Lakhs and Seventy Nine Thousand only)** and matching 2% Tax Collected at Source (TCS) amounting to **Rs.1,97,580- (Rupees One Lakh, Ninety Seven Thousand, Five Hundred Eighty Only)** vide CDR No. 408018 dated 14.03.2024 and DD No. 820392 dated 14.03.2024 respectively submitted by you have been received through Deputy Commissioner, Jammu;

**And Whereas**, under Rule 13 and Rule 26 (2) of *The Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Concession, Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining Rules 2016*, submission of duly approved Mining Plan, Environmental Clearance and Consent to Operate is mandatory for grant of any Mineral Concession;

**And Whereas**, this Directorate vide letter No. 1499/MCC/DGM/EAB/B-4/J/2024/1711 dated 20.03.2024 read with No.1500/MCC/DGM/EAB/B-30/J/2024/4291 dated 16.08.2024 and No.4749 dated 10.09.2024 submitted the case to Administrative Department (Mining) for accord of necessary approval under sub-rule (8) of Rule 55 of SRO-105 of 2016 dated 31.03.2016;



**And Whereas**, the Administrative Department (Mining) vide communication No. GM-MNG/47/ 2024-04 dated 17.09.2024 has conveyed the approval to the acceptance of highest bid offered by you.

**Now therefore**, in view of the above and as per Rule 55(9) of these Rules, the **Letter of Intent (LoI)** is hereby issued with the following directions:-


1. To submit Approved Mining Plan, Environmental Clearance, Consent to Operate and the balance 50% of bid amount (highest bid) with 2% matching tax (TCS) at an earliest or within a period provided under rules, whichever is less, enabling this office to grant Mining Lease in your favour for extraction of minor minerals (RBM) from **Minor Mineral Block No. 30/J** with the description, '**Sardan Nallah District, Jammu**'.
2. No mining/extraction shall be allowed from the said Minor Mineral block till the formal Mining Lease is granted under rules.

***This Letter of Intent (LoI) is provisional and shall be further subject to obtaining any other requisite/statutory clearance under any Law/Rules governing the subject and shall also be subject to the outcome of any Writ Petition(s) pending before any Court of Law including concerning any third party dispute, as may be applicable to this case.***
