CIRCULAR

It has been observed that Royalty with Income Tax received from Principal Executing Agencies/Principal Employers/Government Departments engaged in developmental works are not deposited in relevant heads by District Mineral Officers and the validity of Demand Drafts gets expired after 03 months necessitating their revalidation.

In view of the above, all the District Mineral Officers of J&K (UT) are hereby enjoined upon to deposit the royalty amount along with Income Tax amount in the relevant heads, received from the Principal Executing Agencies/ Principal Employers/ Government Departments, engaged in the developmental projects of Central/UT of J&K, within a period of one month from the date of issuance of Short Term Permit/Disposal Permit in their favour.
