Subject:- Application for Grant of Mining Lease of Minor Mineral over an area of 4.50 hectares at Village Gurha Jagir Tehsil Akhnoor District.

Whereas, application was received by this office for grant of Mining Lease over an area of 4.50 hectares under Khasra No. 187/1 at Village Gurha Jagir Tehsil Akhnoor District, Jammu under Rule 28(1) of the Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Concession, Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining Rules, 2016.

Whereas, as per NOC of Revenue Authorities the land measuring 90 Kanals (4.50 hectares) being issued in favour of Smt. Kunti Devi D/o Budhi Singh R/o Gurha Jagir Tehsil Akhnoor District, Jammu leased out in favour of Sh. Romesh Singh S/o Sh. Naseeb Singh R/o Mawa Karora Tehsil Akhnoor District, Jammu through lease deed registered by Sub Registrar Akhnoor on 29.05.2020.

Whereas, as per Site Plan of the applied area, Minor Mineral Block (RBM) in Gurha Jagir Khad at Village Gurha Jagir Tehsil, Akhnoor District, Jammu over an area of 4.50 hectares with Geo-Coordinates (A=32° 54' 7.30" N 74° 38' 3.87" E, B=32° 54' 7.27" N 74° 38' 5.84" E, C=32° 54' 18.93" N 74° 38' 6.05" E, D=32° 54' 30.71" N 74° 38' 3.88" E, E= 32° 54' 29.94" N 74° 38' 1.13" E, F= 32° 54' 18.50" N 74° 38' 3.67" E) was physically verified on the ground through a Committee of Officers of the Department who reported that all the parameters have been found correct. The Committee also stated that the occurrence of minor minerals collectively designated as RBM in the block proposed has been sufficiently found exposed.

Whereas, the case has been recommended by the Joint Director(J) Geology and Mining Deptt; Jammu vide letter No. 78/JDJ/R.Singh/J/Q.L/2020-21/1633 dated 5.8.2020.


Whereas, TDS/TCS shall have to be paid by you as applicable under Income tax Act, 1961 before grant of Mineral Concession;

Whereas, under Rule 26(2), submission of duly approved Mining Plan and Environmental Clearance is mandatory for grant of any Mineral Concession;

Whereas, J&K Pollution Control Board vide their communication No. SPCB/NGT/60/019/134-37 dated 12.11.2019 has informed that no extraction of the minor minerals shall be allowed from the auctioned blocks unless consented by the J&K PCB under Water(Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air(Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981;

Now, therefore in view of the above, you are hereby advised to submit Approved Mining Plan, Environmental Clearance & Consent to Operate within a period of six months enabling this office to grant Mining Lease in your favour for extraction of minor minerals (River Bed Material) from the above said block. You shall not extract or allow extraction till the Mining Lease under rules is granted.

This shall be further subject to obtaining NOC from the Deputy Commissioner, Jammu/NDC /Stake Holder Departments/Collector Land Acquisition PWD(R&B) concerned/any other third party dispute/requirement/statutory clearance under any Law/Rules governing the subject.
