**Whereas**, an application was received by this office from Sh. Amit Andotra S/o Sh. Karan Singh for grant of Mining Lease over an area of 2.997 Hectares under Khasra No: 144 & 146 at village Chak Gadhaddhar, Sahar Khad Tehsil & District Kathua;

**Whereas**, as per NOC of Revenue authorities vide No. DCK/SQ/2017-18/503-05 dated 19.06.2017, the land measuring 37 Kanals 14 Marlas being issued in favour of Prem Singh, Karan Singh, Rajinder Singh, Davinder Singh, Sukhdev Singh all sons of Channo Devi (Widow) of Late Sh. Dhyan Singh through their attorney holder Sh. Amit Andotra S/o Sh. Karan Singh R/o Village Chack Gadha Dhar, Tehsil & District Kathua;

**Whereas**, under sub rule(2) of Rule, 45 of the J&K Minor Mineral Concession storage Transportation of Minerals and prevention of Illegal Mining rules 2016, the case was considered & processed for grant of quarry license instead of Mining lease over an area of 1.878 hectares only as per NOC from Revenue authorities issued from the office of Deputy Commissioner vide letter No. DCK/SQ/2017-18/503-05 dated 19-06-2017;

**Whereas**, under rule 43 of SRO 105- of 2016 dated 31.03.2016, Letter of Intent has been issued in favour of applicant namely Amit Andotra S/o Sh. Karan Singh R/o Village Chack Gadha Dhar, Tehsil & District Kathua with the direction to submit the approved mining plan, Environmental Clearance from Competent authority.

**Whereas**, Consent to Operate from JK PCB Jammu and other NOC's required under rule 48(2) of Said Rules etc are pre-requisite for granting Quarry License;

**Whereas**, the Mining plan was approved by the Competent Authority vide No. DGM/DD(EG)/MP/18-19/1089-90 dated 21-02-2019;

**Whereas**, the Environmental Clearance was granted by the Department of JKEIAA vide letter No: JKEIAA/2020/178/383-391 dated 26.02.2020;

**Whereas**, the Consent to Establish/operate has been granted by the JKPCB vide letter No. PCB/digital/20041433723 of 2020 dated 05.05.2020 read with Corrigendum issued vide No. JKPCB/T/C/2020/360-63 dated: 10-07-2020;

**Whereas**, NOCs required under rule 48(2) of Provisio of 1 & 2 have been issued by Irrigation, Flood Control department & Forest Department vide their office letters Nos: IDK/7324-25 dated: 09-03-2017, FCDK/4855-56 Dated: 15-03-2017 & KFD/2016-17/10/83-84 Dated: 15-03-2017;

**Whereas**, the applicant has applied in accordance with The J&K Minor Mineral Concession, Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining Rules 2016 for grant of Quarry License in respect of Private Land and has deposited with the Department the sum of Rs. 1.00 lacs as Security vide TDR No. 274305 dated 28.07.2020 and TDR No. 274324 dated 7.8.2020 under rule 49 & Bank Guarantee

amounting Rs. 1.00 lacs vide No.06841PBG2007001 dated 29.07.2020 as Financial Assurance under rule-9 valid upto 28.07.2025 and the sum of Rs.5,000/- vide DD No.-000184 dated 27.04.2018 as application fee for Quarry License under rule 46 of SRO-105 dated: 31-03-2016

### **Location and area of the License**

All the tract of lands situated at village **Gadhadhar, Sahar Khad** Tehsil & District, **Kathua** falling under Khasra No. **144 & 146** containing an area of 1.878 hectares or thereabouts delineated on plan here to annexed and bounded with Geo-coordinates (A= 32° 22' 53.60" N 75° 28' 35.67" E, B= 32° 22' 55.20" N 75° 28' 33.40" E, C= 32° 22' 59.58" N 75° 28' 38.14" E, D= 32° 22' 57.15" N 75° 28' 36.70" E, E= 32° 22' 0.25" N 75° 28' 40.07" E, F=32° 22' 58.96" N 75° 28' 42.18" E) hereinafter referred to as the said lands.

### **The Permission shall be granted in favour of the Applicant for extraction of Minor Minerals subject to fulfill the below mentioned Conditions:-**

- 1) The licensee shall pay advance royalty to the Department on monthly basis on the quantity of the minor mineral intended to be dispatched from the quarry at the rates specified in the **Schedule-I**(amended from time to time) after making such payment by the licensee, the officer authorized in this behalf shall within his jurisdiction issue the authorization for lifting/removal of the said quantity in Form **QL3**.
- 2) The licensee shall remove the quarry waste dumped during excavation or pay such amount per year or part thereof to the Department for removal of quarry waste dumped during the extraction at such rate and at such time as may be fixed by Department from time to time.
- 3) The licensee shall start work in the quarry within ten days of the grant of license and shall thereafter continue to work effectively in a proper skillful and workman like manner with regard to conservation of mineral and safety of labourers and surroundings.
- 4) The licensee shall maintain and at all times keep intact boundary pillars at the corners of the plot/area according to the approved site plan.

- 5) The licensee shall abide by the instructions of the Department regarding the working of the quarry, removal of waste, drainage and other matters concerned with the systematic development and working of the area.
- 6) The licensee shall make to the reasonable satisfaction and pay such compensation as may be determined by lawful authority in accordance with the law or rules or order in force on the subject for damages, injuries or disturbances which may be caused by him and shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Department against all such damages, injuries or disturbances and all costs and expenses incurred thereon or therewith.
- 7) The licensee shall without any delay report to the Department any accident which may occur at or in the said premises and also the discovery in or around the license area of any mineral not specified in the license.
- 8) The license may be cancelled by the Director without giving any notice if the licensee fails to start work at the said quarry or does not work it for a continuous period of four months.
- 9) The minor mineral left on the expiry of license period or cancellation of license shall be removed by licensee within 15 days of the expiry of license or receipt of the order of cancellation of license.
- 10) The licensee shall confine his workings within the limits of the minor mineral plot allotted to him and shall not undertake Quarrying outside his plot. In case the licensee is found working outside the boundary of his allotted plot/area, the license may be cancelled.
- 11) The licensee shall not obstruct approach to the adjoining licensees. In case of any dispute about the approach road, directions of Director or officer Incharge shall be final and binding.
- 12) The licensee shall have to make the transportation of mineral removed from the plot/area under a proper challan in **Form A**.
- 13) The lessee shall adhere the norms/instructions fixed by the District Administration regarding Sale Price of Raw/Processed minor minerals.

- 14) The licensee shall carry out mining activity with safe distances from the bridge, embankment and taking into the account the structural parameters, locational aspects and flow rate etc.
  - 15) The licensee shall adhere the provisions of Mines and Minerals(Development and Regulation) Act 1957, Forest (Conservation) Act 1980, Environment Protection Act 1986, Jammu and Kashmir Water Resources (Regulation and Management) Act 2010, J&K State Fisheries Act, 1960 and the rules made thereunder including the Rules/restrictions/general conditions laid down in SRO-105 dated 31.03.2016.
  - 16) The Licensee shall work strictly as per approved Mining Plan and guidelines/ Conditions of Environmental Clearance/CTE/CTO.
  - 17) The Licensee shall adhere the instructions/orders of MoEF&CC, NGT, Stake Holder Departments & District Administration etc. issued from time to time.
  - 18) The Licensee shall commence the mining operation only after demarcation of the licensed area by the Department.
