Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Ganderbal vide letter referred above has submitted list of affected quarry holders of Safapora Quarry Belt, land measuring over an area of 50 Kanals in Khasra No. 1086 identified at Pehlipora Safapora for the rehabilitation of affected quarry holders.

Whereas, vide this office letter No. 1126/MCC/DGM/DMO/09/4740 dated 16.11.2018 the reference of Deputy Commissioner along with list of affected quarry holders were forwarded to the Joint Director(K) for providing Geo-referenced map of the Pahlipora, Ganderbal for declaring the said quarry belt as Cluster of Quarries.

Whereas, Joint Director(K) No.MSM/DGM/SGR/F-06/2056 dated 7.12.2018 submitted the Geo-referred map of the block "ABCDEFGHA" comprising an area of 2.5 hectares at Pahlipora, Ganderbal.


Now, in pursuance to the provisions of Rule 14 of the Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Concession, Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining Rules 2016, the proposed Block "ABCDEFGHA" comprising an area of 2.5 hectares is declared as **Clusters of quarries** as depicted in the enclosed Map with the details of the affected quarry holders to be accommodated in cluster given in the Annexure "A1" (authenticated by Naib Tehsildar and Patwari Halqa Safapora).

The mode of Mineral Concession in the form of Quarry Licence under the provisions of Rule, 44 of the Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Concession, Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining Rules 2016 has the following pre - requisites as per the provisions of Rule (15) and (43) of the above said rules for each Cluster:-

1. Approved Mining Plan.
2. Environment Management Plan (EMP).

In view of the above, the affected quarry holders of Safapora Quarry Belt rehabilitated at " Pahlipora " are advised to submit the above said documents enabling this Department to grant formal Quarry License.
